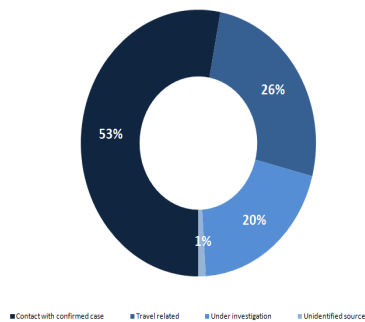

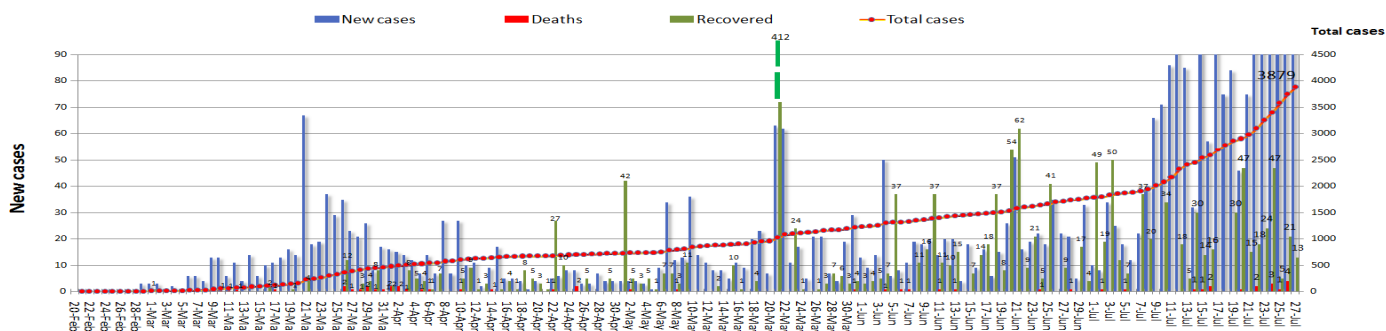
## Status of cases



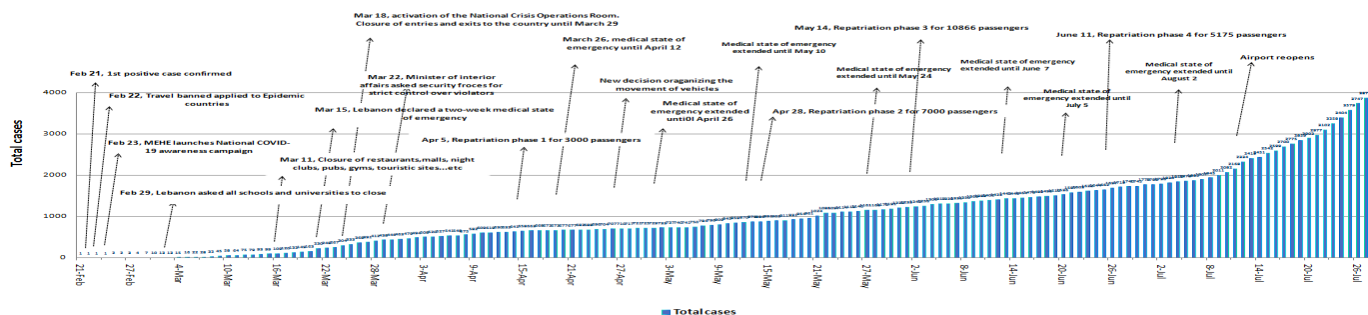

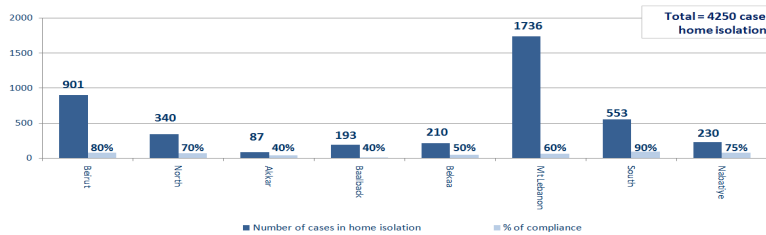
## Cases per day



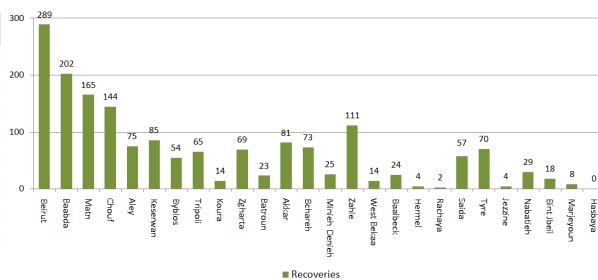
## Chronology of decisions according to number of cases



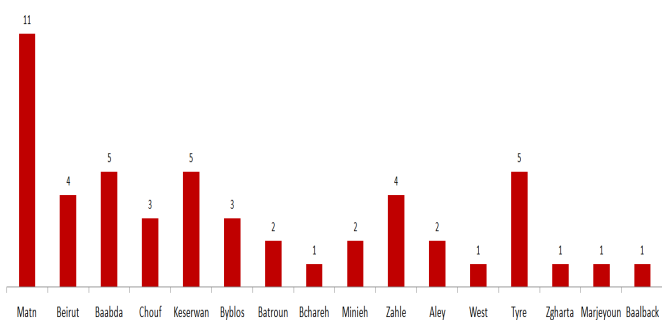
## Number of individuals in home isolation and percent-age of commitment to isolation



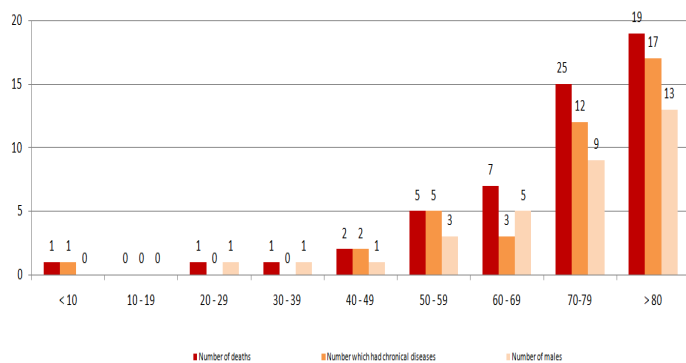
## Distribution of recoveries by area

## Ministry of Interior and Municipalities

- The ministry issued Memorandum No. 74 / AM / 2020 on 23/7/2020 regarding the procedures and measures required to face this stage of the virus spread, whereby all citizens are asked to resume full compliance with public safety measures. those who fail to adhere to these measures will face consequences of Article 604 of The Penal Code. in addition owners of all public and private institutions should adhere to the maximum public safety measures

## Ministry of Public Works and Transport

- The General Directorate of Civil Aviation at the Ministry of Public Works and Transport issued Circular No. 44/2 on 7/21/2020 to all airlines operating in Rafic Hariri International Airport regarding the transportation of passengers to Syria via the airport, where they were asked not to allow these passengers to board the planes heading to Lebanon without having conducted a PCR test that yielded a negative result maximum 96 hours prior the date of the flight, in addition to not transporting foreign passengers to Syria via the airport without the prior approval of the Syrian authorities with the exception of the Palestinian refugees in Syria and members of international organizations and diplomatic missions operating in Syria.

## General Decisions

The council of ministers issued the decision no. 137/2020 on 27/7/2020 on the precautionary measures to control the spread of the virus, which included:

- the sectors that will be closed from 28/7/2020 and 10/8/2020. the restaurant and cafes capacity was set at 50%.
- the precautionary measures that will be taken on sea and land borders and in the airport

c. closing the whole country from 30/7/2020 till 3/8/2020 and from 6/8/2020 till 10/8/2020.

## Examples of lack of adherence to safety measures

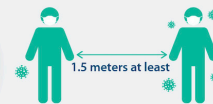
- Demonstration, and Roadblocks
