GOVERNANCE

Priority Action 6 – Adopt a time-bound plan for restructuring the sector to privatize EDL's generation plants and establish private concessions for distribution services, starting 2022 after expiry of the existing distribution service provider (DSP) contracts

Priority Action 7 – Establish a planning department at the Ministry of Energy and Water (MEW).

Priority Action 8 – Develop a contract between the Government and EDL to set specific performance targets and compliance conditions for EDL's operations over the next 4-5 years.

Priority Action 9 – Adopt a time-bound plan to modernize EDL's operations, in line with the sector restructuring plan.

Priority Action 10 – Significantly increase public communications regarding the Government's plans in the sector, including, but not limited to, the rationale underpinning those plans, timeframe expected to accomplish the anticipated milestones, and the associated costs.

SECURITY

Priority Action 11 – Launch procurement for the Salaata plant (after completing necessary environmental and social assessments in compliance with international standards) and assess competitiveness of Deir Amar II proposals to determine whether a competitive procurement process is needed.

Priority Action 12 – Adopt a utility-scale RE program that reflects best practices and provides annual targeted capacity segregated by technology to implement the Government's announced 2030 RE policy objectives.
